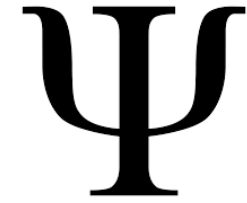


Psychology A-Level AQA



This course is **linear**; there will be **3 examinations** at the end of the two years. There will be a mix of **multiple choice**, **point based** and **level response questions**. Each exam is 2 hours long
